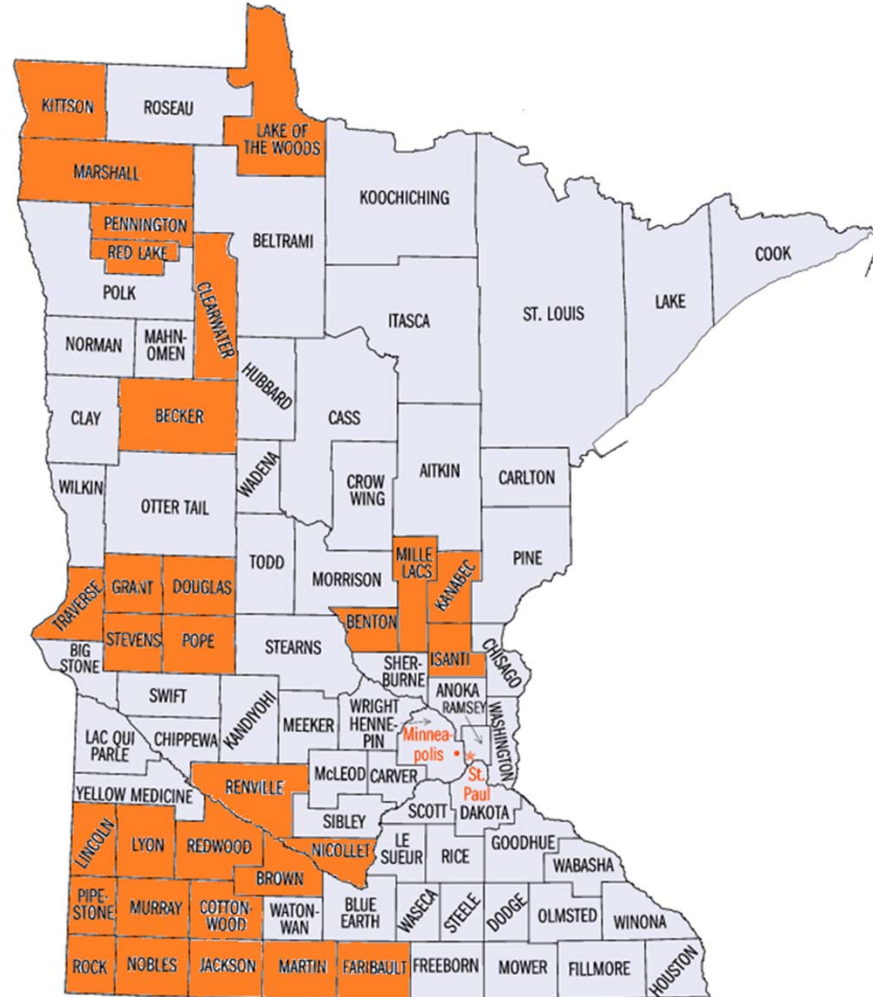

## 4. Grant Opportunity

- MDH will fund projects to expand electronic data exchange at the local level
- Total funding \$2 million, up to \$25,000 per partner
- Oct 2012 to Sept 2013
- One-to-three in-kind match required
- At least one partner must be eligible for federal Meaningful Use funds
- First-come first-serve funding



 <b>Provider Directory</b> Find providers that are part of your network and get contact information.			
 <b>Secure Messaging</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Send and receive secure messages from other healthcare providers</li> <li>Look-up other healthcare providers in a directory</li> <li>Access your secure inbox through the Web or with Microsoft Outlook</li> </ul>			
 <b>Chart to Chart</b> Send supported documents directly to Public Health. For example, Epic Software sending a CCD directly into Nightingale Notes Software and adding it to the patient's chart.  <b>NOTE:</b> Nightingale Notes will have this capability during the project, but other vendors must develop similar capability in order to provide this option to your agency. Project plans include work with multiple vendors.			
 <b>Provider to Payer</b> Send patient information to select payers.			future

## 9. Good News! You can participate.

- Even without additional integration development from your software vendor, you can have basic, secure data exchange for 1 year free as part of this program in addition to the other project benefits.
- We need volunteers/nominations for:
  - **Local Project Lead:** liaison with partner agencies, with other localities doing similar projects, and with the state
  - **Fiscal Agent:** responsible to cut checks, receipt in money and prepare the quarterly grant report to be submitted for reimbursement
